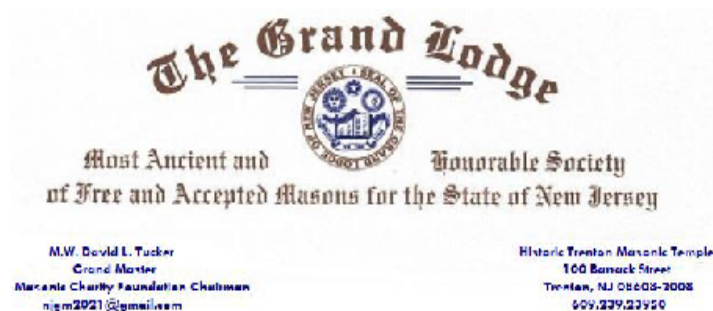


CLOSING CHARGE
